

### **Key People**

**Richard Steiff** 



In Germany, Richard Steiff based one of his toy designs on a bear he saw at the zoo. In 1902 the Steiff company started making teddy bears.

Ole Kirk Christiansen Ole Kirk Christiansen called his toy company 'Lego' in 1939. The plastic blocks were made in 1949.



Ruth Handler invented the Barbie doll in 1959. She named the doll after her daughter Barbara.

### **Key Facts**

Toys have existed for thousands of years. They were made out of materials that were available at the time, even stones and string have been made into toys.

Modern toys are mainly made of plastic. This is because it is usually safer and easier to make things with.

Many modern toys use electricity to work. Computers and consoles were invented in the 20th century.
