The School Day



- **School Day: 8:50am—3:20pm**
- **Break: 15 minutes within the am session**
- **Lunch: 1 hour – eat lunch and play**
- Very similar to Reception to begin with. Lots of opportunity to use indoor and outdoor learning areas.
- Main difference is a set playtime in the morning with Year 2.
- The children will play on the KS1 playground at playtime and at lunch.

Wrap Around Care

- Morning Club - This will be a flat rate cost of £3.00 (free for children eligible for Pupil premium). This does include breakfast (toast or cereal). Booking for breakfast club can be done by contacting the school office. The morning club starts at 7.45am and drop off is to the Multipurpose room at the side of school by the staff car park.
- Wrap around after school club – This is currently being considered to start in September. This will be a flat rate of £5.00 per session and will be from 3:20pm when school finished to 5:20pm
- After school clubs - These will be curriculum enhancement clubs and run weekly. After school clubs will run in 10 week blocks so please make sure you check the start dates and end dates as they do not run the full term. Clubs will run until 4.30pm and the cost of a 10 week block will be £20 to cover staffing and resources (Pupil Premium children will be entitled to 1 free block). Please keep a look out on Class Dojo in early September for when to sign up.

Curriculum

- Curriculum with lots of variety - now under subject headings.
- Start off with lots of continuous provision that is linked to learning, similar to Reception.
- Work towards more whole class learning.
- Daily phonics, reading and mental maths sessions.
- Two PE sessions a week

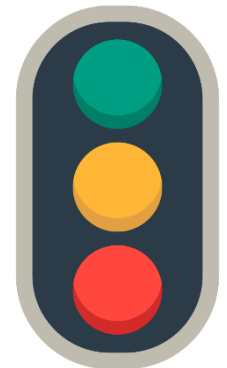

Uniform and Equipment

- Name inside all clothes especially jumpers and cardigans

Work at Home

- **Daily reading** – record in their reading diary (4 times per week) RWI and book bag book
- Number task (NumBots & TT Rock Stars in the Summer Term 3 times per week)
- RWI online speed sound session



Reading

- The children will continue to develop their reading and writing abilities through our daily Read Write Inc sessions.
- They will be assessed regularly to help them progress and work with adults across Key Stage 1.
- The children will receive either a Ditty Sheet or coloured book that is appropriate to their fluency of reading. This needs to be brought to school everyday.
- There will be a phonics Screening test WC 10th June, however more information will be shared via a meeting closer to the time.
