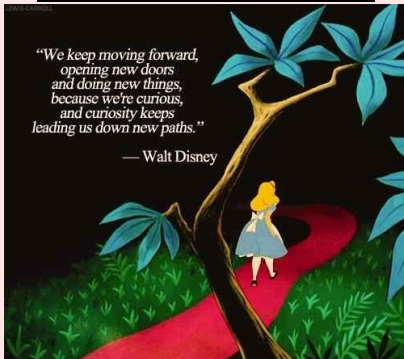
Parent Workshops continue - You are warmly invited into class to work with your child on various activities. All workshops start at 2.30pm. For more details please speak with your child's class teacher.
